Q: Why doesn't my printer work with my PrintServer?

A: Many kinds of printers are **not** suitable to network printing. They include host-based, sometimes referred to as GDI*, PPA*, CAPT* and low duty cycle printers. They are designed for home use that are not intended for support on a traditional network. In addition, several HP OfficeJet are not designed for or supported on networks.

*: GDI (Graphical Device Interface)
PPA (Printing Performance Architecture)
CAPT (Canon Advanced Printing Technology)

Host-based. A printer that relies on the computer's CPU to transform the print job. Most host-based printers use the GDI interface built into Windows (hence the "GDI printer" term), so there is no need to convert the data to PostScript, PCL, or other printer language.

Some HP DeskJet printers are PPA printers. With this new printing system, the printer handles only basic printer functions while the printer software on the computer handles the formatting. The software driver handles all formatting,

such as color matching and correction, half-toning, edge enhancement, tone correction, and ink management.

Some of the Canon laser printer comprehensive job control via Canon Advanced Printing Technology (CAPT) driver software including voice guidance, Toner Saver and Automatic Image Refinement modes.

The printer design with Low Duty Cycle is to prevent the printer heating, in high volume network printing, this function will let the printserver buffer overflow, so that this kind of printer can print fine in the beginning, but not for a long time.

Furthermore, some of the printers listed below may work on a network, but only when they are connected to the parallel port of a Windows computer that has the correct printer driver installed and printer sharing properly configured. Contact the support group for you specific printer for details.
